

TN Safety Coordinator

PASSENGER / CO-RIDER

Whether you call them a passenger or co-rider, they are a very important person (VIP) and should always be treated with respect.

Following are some tips for riding with this VIP.

- Proper Gear Just because there is someone on the back of the bike does not mean they do not need protection in the form of a quality jacket, boots, helmet and gloves.
- Expectation Talk about everything, including the parts of the motorcycle, the need for leaning and looking over your inside shoulder in turns and how best to communicate with each other on the road (especially if no headset is used).
- Take It Easy As the rider/operator you're just not responsible for your own safety, but that of you co-rider/passenger, as well. Watch your speed and aggressiveness, and keep in mind that your bike will handle differently with your co-rider. Be smooth, focus on being predictable and remember that passengers might make unexpected movements, which could suddenly make things very scary.
- Planning Hey, riding together means planning together. Just because you

- are up front in control does not make this a monarchy. The co-rider is to have an active role in the plans of the trip, including stops along the way.
- Listen When your co-rider talks "listen to them". They may observe something that you do not or did not see. Two sets of eyes are better than one set. Stop when the co-rider wants/needs to. Also, keeping them within their comfort level is good practice.

Remember, you both are doing this to have fun. So, since there are different strokes for different people, be flexible. The ride and time together will be more enjoyable.

Enjoy the riding adventures of ones to come and remember the good times of the past.
